From the East

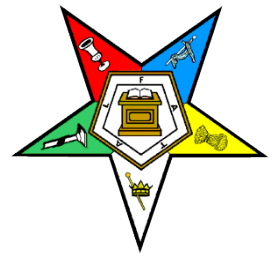

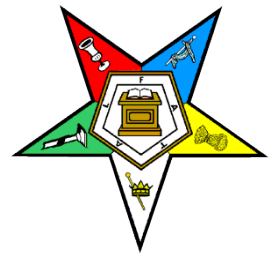
